How does Rose House use the funds raised from these events?

1. Van Project

Both the golf outing and the 5K race will help us purchase a new transport van. These vans are needed to bring our residents from all six of our homes to medical appointments, day programs and fun events. Rose House does not receive funding from the State of New Jersey or Medicaid for these vans, which is why your support is especially appreciated.

2. Forever Home Project

Proceeds from the 50-50 raffle will help us build independent living apartments, featuring 10 to 12 single-occupancy units, specifically designed for adults with developmental disabilities. Trained caregivers will be available daily for residents who to be integrated into the local community through employment and social events.
